LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Paulding County, Ohio until Wednesday, March 20, 2023 at 11:00 A.M., at which time and place, bids will be opened and read for 703 Aggregate for use by the Paulding County Highway Department. Bidding documents and specifications will be issued at the Office of the Paulding County Engineer. They can also be found online under the "Bids" tab at www.pauldingcountyengineer.com.

Bids must be submitted on the forms provided by the Engineer.

Bids may be hand delivered or mailed in a sealed envelope bearing the Bidder's name and address and marked "Sealed Bid for 703 Aggregate".

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids. Multiple awards may be made for various types of aggregate.

Factors which will determine ultimate purchases by Paulding County are; unit bid prices, terms of purchase, location of project, availability of gradation, type of material desired for a particular application, cost of transporting from pickup site to County stockpile, quality of product, and/or type of surface desired. If available, prices are requested for washed #9A stone.

No bid will be considered unless it be accompanied by a bond executed by a surety company authorized to do business in the State of Ohio or a certified check from a solvent bank in the amount of five (5%) percent of the total bid to guarantee that if said bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into and the performance of it properly secured.

SCOPE

The Paulding County Engineer is seeking bids for 703 aggregate to be used by the Paulding County Highway Department for various maintenance operations during 2023.

SPECIFICATIONS

The purpose of these specifications is to provide Paulding County Highway Department with various grades of crushed aggregate meeting the requirements of the 2019 State of Ohio Department of Transportation Construction and Materials Specifications.

Bids are requested, not required, for No.'s 4, 8, 9, 9A washed, ½" Mill Run, 304, 411, 6/57, Dump Rock-Type "C" and Dump Rock-Type "D", F.O.B. Paulding County trucks at the pickup site. Factors which will determine ultimate purchases by Paulding County include; unit bid prices, terms of purchase, location of project, cost of transporting from pickup site to County stockpile, availability of gradation, type of material desired for a particular application, quality of product, and type of surface desired.

Award of contract shall be conditioned in part upon the above-mentioned purchasing factors. The proposed quantities are for reference only and do not reflect the amount of aggregate the county intends or estimates to purchase. Multiple awards may be made for various types of aggregate.

PRICE BID - The price bid for 703 aggregate shall be the unit price per ton, F.O.B. Paulding County trucks at the pickup site and shall be effective from April 1, 2023 through March 31, 2023.

PROOF OF INSURANCE

Vendors are required to furnish the County with a certificate of insurance in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 primary and \$1,000,000.00 umbrella coverage. The County, its elected office and employees shall be named as additional insured with respect to all activities under any agreement resulting from this bidding. The certificate of insurance shall provide that such insurance shall not be cancelled without thirty (30) days prior written notice to the County. Vendors will replace certificate for any insurance expiring prior to the effective end date under any agreement resulting from this bidding.

WORKER'S COMPENSATION

Vendors shall maintain Worker's Compensation coverage as required by Ohio law. A copy of a valid Worker's Compensation certificate shall be submitted with the bid.

INDEMNIFICATION/HOLD HARMLESS

The vendor shall indemnify and hold harmless the County, its agents and employees from any and all losses, claims, damages, lawsuits, costs, judgments, expenses or any other liabilities which they may incur as a result of bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or injury to or destruction of tangible property including the loss of use resulting there from, caused in whole or part by the negligent act or omission of the vendor or any person directly or indirectly employed by any of them or any person for whose acts any of them may be liable.

VERIFICATION OF "NO FINDING FOR RECOVERY"

No political subdivision shall award a contract for goods, services, or construction to a person against whom a Finding for Recovery has been issued by the Auditor of State, if the Finding for Recovery is unresolved.

The undersigned, by their signature and title, document that no "Finding for Recovery" is outstanding for the bidder.
